

Enforcement of New Town Codes - Be a Good Neighbor!

The following changes to the Town Code are **now in effect**. They were enacted by the Town Board upon the recommendation of the Code Update Committee and after Public Hearings on the proposed changes.

No Parking on Grass in Residential Districts

- In residential areas, all cars and trucks must be parked on the driveway.

Parking on the grass in residential areas is no longer permitted. This includes cars, trucks and any vehicle for which a registration is required.

This change was carefully considered but was very important to many residents, members of the Code Update Committee and the Town Board as they all feel it has a real impact on the appearance of neighborhood properties.



Driveways

For any driveways installed, expanded, paved or otherwise improved:

- The driveway must be paved with asphalt or concrete.
- The maximum width of the driveway is the greatest of twenty feet or one foot beyond the garage dimensions on the entrance side of the garage.
- Driveways cannot be located closer than eight feet to the property line.

Driveway Extensions

- Driveway extensions will allow homeowners to park campers or boats, etc. next to their garage. Automobiles and trucks **are not** allowed to be parked on driveway extensions.
- For any driveway extensions installed, expanded, paved or otherwise improved:
 - Driveway extensions have to be made of asphalt, concrete, or crushed stone with a minimum depth of six inches.
 - Cannot be wider than ten feet and no closer to the property line than five feet.
 - Cannot extend beyond the rear of the garage structure.

❖ At this point the Town is focusing on educating residents about the code changes. After that we will move to more active enforcement.
