## **LEGAL NOTICE PUBLIC HEARING**

A public hearing will be held on **Wednesday, August 28, 2013 at 7:00 P.M.** in the Henrietta Town Hall, 475 Calkins Road, Henrietta, New York before the Zoning Board of Appeals of the Town of Henrietta regarding the following applications:

1. Application 2013-075 of Jermaine M. White requesting a variance for a 6 foot high fence in front yard (with a 33 foot front setback), whereas a 3 foot high fence is allowed by code on property located at 77 Glen Acre Drive.
2. Application 2013-076 of Annette and Larry Christensen requesting a variance to allow parking of cars or trucks on driveway extension, whereas only other legal vehicles, not cars or trucks (boats, trailers, RV's etc.) are allowed by code on property located at 332 Goodburlet Road.
3. Application 2013-077 of Yogurt City requesting a variance for a second wall sign, whereas only one wall sign is allowed by code on property located at 3300 West Henrietta Road.
4. Application 2013-078 of Matthew and Denise Becker requesting a variance for a 6 foot high fence in front property, whereas a 3 foot high fence is allowed by code on property located at 195 East Path Rise.
5. Application 2013-079 of Yolickity LLC requesting a variance for a second wall sign, whereas only one wall sign is allowed by code on property located at 1000 Hylan Drive.
6. Application 2013-080 of Yolickity LLC requesting a variance for 107 square feet of signage, whereas 68 square feet of signage is allowed by code on property located at 1000 Hylan Drive.
