Join us at our new Winterfest Event to be held on Saturday, January 31st from 11:00am - 3:00pm. This event is free and will be held at Veteran's Memorial Park near Bushman and Roberts Cabin. Bundle up and we hope to see you there.

The Town is preparing to implement online registration so you can register and pay for programs without having to do so in person at the Town Hall. We want to make sure we are well prepared for this so that it can be an easy transition for all. We are hoping to begin online registration for our Fall 2015 season. More information will be released in our Summer program brochure as well as on our website at that time.

Please note that there is now a 2.65% fee being added to all credit card transactions as a result of our bank now charging the Town. In the past, the bank "ate" this fee as a courtesy to the Town but this is no longer the case. Since not all residents pay by credit card, it was decided the fee should only be paid by those utilizing credit cards not all Town residents. Debit cards are processed as credit cards so the fee also applies for this use. No fee will be added if paying by cash or check.

We will be offering a Community Garden for Henrietta residents to be able to grow their own crops at Tinker Nature Park. Registration is required along with a program fee. Please refer to page 9 for more information. Limited space is available so please register soon if interested.

The Parks Department is in the process of renovating the former pro shop at Lookup Park into a rentable cabin. Reservations for this cabin will not begin until after its completion sometime this spring. Please continue to check in with our main office for updates on availability.

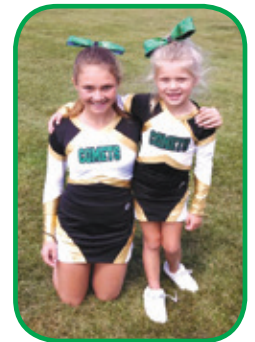

Henrietta Park Information

VETERANS MEMORIAL PARK

Veterans Memorial Park is located adjacent to the Town Hall at 595 Calkins Road. The park has many recreational facilities available to the public, including softball and soccer fields, two cabins, picnic pavilions, basketball & tennis courts, playground equipment, bocce courts, and a fitness trail.

MARTIN ROAD PARK

The Martin Road Park is located at 1344 Martin Road. The park has a large playground, picnic pavilion, community soccer fields and tennis courts.

CABINS/PAVILIONS RESERVATIONS

Bushman Cabin, Roberts Cabin, and three Picnic pavilions may be rented/reserved by registering in advance at the Recreation Department. Both cabins are heated and include indoor restrooms, kitchens with oven/stove, refrigerator, sink, and seating for approximately 50 people. The occupancy limits are 100 people in Bushman and 75 in the Roberts Cabin. Cabins are available for use from 10:30 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. The 2015 rental fee is \$100 for Henrietta residents, \$175 for all others. The Stevens, Andrews and Buyck Pavilions are available for reservation by Henrietta residents only at no charge. The Chase shelter is available on a first come first served basis.

Reservations for 2015 use of the cabins and pavilions will begin for Henrietta Residents on Monday, December 1st at 9:00am in the Main Meeting room at the Town Hall. All non-residents may begin reserving the facilities Friday, January 2nd. The cabin rental fees for 2015 are residents/\$100, non-residents/\$175.
