SUPERVISOR MOORE

We have one (1) Public Hearing tonight. It's for 63 Chiltren Road. If Mr. Ekwel would come to the microphone and explain where we're at and also if you could come too.

TERRY EKWELL, FIRE MARSHAL / BUILDING INSPECTOR

Over the last year or so, there's been a growing accumulation of wood debris and some clutter at the property of 63 Chiltren Road. We've been working with the residents to try and get the property cleaned up, get the wood in some semblance of order. It was piles of firewood that were piled all over the property, including up to the road and the right-of-way. We did send a letter to the occupant, Ms. Finley and her husband, and to advise them of the fact that the condition of the property was unacceptable of the Town's standards. Since that time, there has been some on-going action at the property where the occupants have been moving the pile of the firewood behind and to the side of the house. It has been stacked. We have pictures that we made available to the Board at the Workshop yesterday showing the amount of work that's been done in the last week or so. At this point in time the action needs to continue, but the property is in a lot better shape than it has been for a long period of time and I think the, with the continued action on the occupants' part, that the property will be in the condition that's acceptable for our Property Maintenance Code.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Okay. Thank you. Ma'am did you want to speak...your name and address first.

DONNA FINLEY, 63 CHILTERN ROAD

Donna Finley, 63 Chiltern Road. We will continue to clean that up. There is some wood that's covered in our driveway. We'd like to keep that there for the winter so we can use it for our wood burning stove and it will be gone in the spring, if that's acceptable.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Okay, you'll have to clear that through Mr. Ekwel as you move forward, but we do appreciate your cooperation.

DONNA FINLEY, 63 CHILTERN ROAD

Okay, yeah, it's actually a blessing because I hated it there, so...

Well, actually I talked to a couple of your neighbors today and they were very pleased that you were cleaning it up, but they said you were doing all the work.

I do a lot of it, yes.

*(From audience, Lynne Stewart, 225 Viscount Drive "Well you might not be so thrilled when I... (inaudible)"*

LYNNE STEWART, 225 VISCOUNT DRIVE

First, I want to thank you for the wonderful recognition of Mel and Barbara Witmer. Mel said later he declined it being, the name being changed because it's GPS and a lot of people would get confused, but anyway, thank you so much, and Janet was amazing as the M.C. I didn't come to the October 1<sup>st</sup> Meeting and I did pick up a copy of the Budget. I kind of understand it. It looks, my own church budget has columns just like that, but it's all line items that I can figure. But I do have a question. I have a very small church congregation that I'm part of; there's only forty (40) or fifty (50) there on Sunday, but out of that number of people there's about sixteen (16) of us on the Senior, that go to the Senior Center all the time. I'm not one (1) of the them because I'm not quite old enough yet; I'm just joking, I am, but I don't, I have other things that I do. They're not very happy with quite a few things; some things that have been cut, some of the busing to programs like to Vollmer to do volunteer work. That nice little perk that I thought was one of the sweetest things that the Senior Center used to do; you get five dollars (\$5.00) gift certificate to Wegmans if they won bingo, that's no longer there. But the thing that they're most upset about, and I looked back at the Minutes before this afternoon, May 21<sup>st</sup> when Ruth Turk read into the record about what happened to Shelly Gorino. All the people at my church are very upset about that. I want to know when her pay that was suspended was restored to her.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

It wasn't.

LYNNE STEWART, 225 VISCOUNT DRIVE

Why not?

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Because it was a personnel matter Ma'am and she was found to be not correct in what she did.

LYNNE STEWART, 225 VISCOUNT DRIVE

Really?

SUPERVISOR MOORE

She left a Meeting of the Supervisor, correct.

LYNNE STEWART, 225 VISCOUNT DRIVE

Because she thought she was coming for another topic...

COUNCILMAN BREESE

Can I interrupt you...

LYNNE STEWART, 225 VISCOUNT DRIVE

...and when she got there...

COUNCILMAN BREESE

...just a moment please. Councilor, are we able to go down this road?

DANIEL MASTRELLA, TOWN ATTORNEY

You're certainly not required to discuss a personnel problem, or personnel issues in this Public Forum, you each act individually in that regard. I would advise you not to go into detail on personnel items.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

I would be glad to have you come and see Lynne anytime you want, my door's open, and we can address this issue probably...

LYNNE STEWART, 225 VISCOUNT DRIVE

Would you yell at me the way you yelled at her where everybody could hear? And other people have had the same experience when they come to talk to you. I don't want to come to your office unless I have witnesses with me.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Ma'am, there were two (2) people with me and I don't believe there was any yelling, but you could ask them if you'd like, and I'll make sure that they're both there the day that you come. You somehow have a lot of misinformation. It's kind of like the five dollar (\$5.00) Wegmans gift card that they gave out for Bingo.

LYNNE STEWART, 225 VISCOUNT DRIVE

Yes.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

The State Comptroller in their audit that was released in January stated that we can't do that. It's against the Law. You cannot give away taxpayer dollars. It wasn't anything that we were trying to single the seniors out with at all. It's just something that we have to abide by the Law, and that's what's happening...

LYNNE STEWART, 225 VISCOUNT DRIVE

You can't, Wegmans gift certificates can't be given to people?

COUNCILMAN BREESE  
Because we buy them.

SUPERVISOR MOORE  
We bought them Ma'am with taxpayer dollars. You can't give away taxpayer dollars.

LYNNE STEWART, 225 VISCOUNT DRIVE  
Okay.

COUNCILMAN BREESE  
If Wegmans were to...

SUPERVISOR MOORE  
Okay, it...

COUCILMAN BREESE  
...donate them that would be different.

SUPERVISOR MOORE  
...it has nothing...

LYNNE STEWART, 225 VISCOUNT DRIVE  
Okay.

SUPERVISOR MOORE  
...to do with myself, which you're trying to insinuate. It has to do with the Law.

LYNNE STEWART, 225 VISCOUNT DRIVE  
Okay, that's, thank you.

SUPERVISOR MOORE  
It's just another one of your misconceptions.

LYNNE STEWART, 225 VISCOUNT DRIVE  
Okay, well I'll talk the Senior Citizens at my Church...

SUPERVISOR MOORE  
When...

LYNNE STEWART, 225 VISCOUNT DRIVE  
...then.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

...would you call my Office tomorrow and make an appointment?

LYNNE STEWART, 225 VISCOUNT DRIVE

Probably not.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Well then, I don't know how you're ever going to get the right information.

LYNNE STEWART, 225 VISCOUNT DRIVE

Okay.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

I've tried to come and see the Seniors for the last two (2) weeks to get on the Agenda so I could at least show them the new Budget and I've had to wait two (2) weeks to get on that Agenda.

LYNNE STEWART, 225 VISCOUNT DRIVE

Well, I guess you have to keep trying.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Well, I think I probably sign the person's paycheck that controls the Agenda.

LYNNE STEWART, 225 VISCOUNT DRIVE

Okay. Alright that's all I have to say. Thank you.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Is there anybody else that would like to speak?

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

Mike Stafford, 32 Essex Drive. Before I start I'd like to thank Chris Martin for helping me with this matter even though I'm not real satisfied with what has happened, but he's been a great go-between and person to go to, so I want to, you know he's done a great job I thought trying to help resolve the issue. Back on June 26<sup>th</sup> the Town, Town Crew got a, as Jack knows, got a camera stuck in a pipe between my house and Luxe Spa. They ripped out approximately a thirty foot (30') section of arborbitaes that was my buffer between myself, Luxe Spa, and the corner of Jefferson and Winton. They were about forty feet (40') high and quite full. I went to Jack the next day, he said, "We'll look into it" wanted to take care of it, so they hired, or they had spoke to Broccolo, Broccolo came out and took a look. John from Broccolo said, "Yes, we have arborbitaes that are quite big, tall as those...", and there was one on the end he pointed

at and he said, "About that, as tall as that one." He did say they weren't so full on the bottom, but they would grow in, but he said they were out at his place, out, I think out NY 441. So I went out and looked at them, and the ones I saw were quite big and everything else and they were going to put them in. Well, it turned out that the Town put them in, the Town bought them from Broccolo, I don't know if the Town delivered, if they were delivered to the Town or how they were.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

They were.

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

But they were far, a far cry from what, what I expected. In the meantime or, also on the day they ripped out the arborvitae they, I had some, they're called fire bushes I think...

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Burning bush.

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

...burning bush, thank you. They ripped out two (2) of them and, and really chopped up two (2) more pretty well and I have some pictures of that. But I would like to know if, you know, the ones that got replaced are nowhere near what I have. I know there's some better ones out there on NY 441 that it's in their garden, if I can get some more. And it's just a, I can, I got pictures from you, and I'm sure anybody here would, I'm sure you, nobody on this Board would like to have the view I have now.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Yes, and it was an accident that they even had to be taken out and you and I have been around...

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

Right.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

...and around and I don't disagree with you that on the bottom you could throw a cat through them. They're not...

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

I mean they look half dead.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

...but I don't know where you go to find ones much bigger than that to be honest with you Mike.

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

Well they, I've seen them. They have them, I mean have you been out, have you, I mean...

SUPERVISOR MOORE

No I haven't.

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

...I've been out to Broccolo and saw them.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Right. I had the sales person from Broccolo call you and talk to you and they delivered what they said was what was out there.

COUNCILMAN MULLIGAN

Don't they have a six (6) month or twelve (12) month warranty?

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

Well, I mean, yes twelve (12) month, yes, ok...

COUCILWOMAN ZINCK

You said you have pictures?

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

...a twelve (12) month warranty is not going to, I mean...

SUPERVISOR MOORE

But first off though Mike, they're really not on your property.

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

Well, right, they're not on my property but, but when that place was built they were required to have a buffer so I don't see their parking lot, and I, and I can see, plainly see by these pictures that, that I no longer have that buffer.

COUCILWOMAN ZINCK

Can we see the pictures Mike? I mean just so I know what you're talking about?

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

This one's basically, that one's basically the third (*inaudible*)...on June 26<sup>th</sup> where they cut the hole in.

COUCILWOMAN ZINCK

This is where they were?

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

This is where they were. You can see how the, you can see where the other ones were. I mean that's what I have all the way across.

COUCILWOMAN ZINCK

Okay.

COUCILMAN MULLIGAN

And what do you got now?

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

This is what I got. This is what I got now. And I got some...

COUCILWOMAN ZINCK

I see what you're saying.

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

These were my, these were my burning bushes.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

I came over there and saw them.

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

I had seven (7) of them, I, they took out two (2). This is the one they, this is one of the ones they hacked apart. And this is what the two (2) were replaced with.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

But the trees were actually planted in the easement and any easement we call for them not to be planted...

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

I...

SUPERVISOR MOORE

...in the easement.

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

Well, in your, in the paperwork from 1981 from when you built the place, it says there will be a buffer there and they planted them there because the Town wanted them there, and I thought the easement was fifteen feet (15') from the pipe. When they, when they marked the pipe before they planted, when they marked where the pipe was before they planted new ones, it was more than fifteen feet (15').

SUPERVISOR MOORE

But where was the pipe?

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

The pipe was, the pipe was more than fifteen feet (15') from the easement.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Yes, but when they're digging up a pipe a lot of times they don't know quite where it is when they go to...

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

Well I mean...

SUPERVISOR MOORE

...dig it up.

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

...it, it was like twenty feet (20'), so I mean, when you say they, they weren't planted on the easement, no that's not correct...

SUPERVISOR MOORE

I don't know...

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

...I don't believe.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

...how we resolve this because...

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

Neither do I.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

...we made some type of attempt to correct a problem the best we could and we relied on Broccoli to do the job.

TB October 15, 2014

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

Right. Well, they didn't give you the, I do, I can, I do have another picture of what, it will take me to get it up on my phone, when I was out at Broccolo, you can see one of the trees that, it's much bigger...

SUPERVISOR MOORE

This, this happened...

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

...and much fuller.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

...in July didn't it?

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

It happened June 26<sup>th</sup>.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Yes, okay because we didn't, I said to you that we didn't want to do anything until towards fall so that...

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

Right.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

...whatever we planted wouldn't have to go through the heat of the summer.

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

Right, and they were, correct they were planted, these were planted I believe it was August 24<sup>th</sup>, or I'm sorry September 24<sup>th</sup>...

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Yes.

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

...excuse me, September 24<sup>th</sup>.

COUNCILWOMAN ZINCK

I mean I certainly understand, I do understand they aren't on your property, but I also understand it was your buffer between...

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

Right, okay.

COUCILWOMAN ZINCK

...Jefferson Road and Luxe. Is there any way we could get Broccolo to come and like fill in with a few others? They are pretty sparce.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Yes, but I don't think you're going to get any that are much taller than that. They're sparse at the bottom, there's no question about that. I was very disappointed because I went and saw them the next morning about seven o'clock (7:00)...

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

Right.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

...and I was very disappointed, and that's why I called John because I knew you were going to call me.

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

Right, well of course.

COUCILWOMAN ZINCK

I mean you're not going to get them as tall as the other ones...

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

But there, there...

COUNCILWOMAN ZINCK

...for sure, but I mean, I'm just thinking even if you put a, you know a couple more in to fill it in.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

You're real good friends with Laurie, maybe you can get her...

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

It is sure....

COUCILWOMAN ZINCK

I'm sure she'll run right over.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

...to do some type of a warranty work.

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

...I think, I don't think they were the same bushes that, I mean that I looked at. They, they're a lot sparser at the bottom and they're not, and as John from Broccolo said they were going to be as tall as the one on the end, and the one on the end is a little shorter than the rest of them.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Yes, see I can't say because I didn't see them.

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

Yes, right. Well, I need to, I mean, I'm sure nobody on the Board would like to have the new view off their patio or off their deck that I have, you know, of Winton and Jefferson that I never had for the last four (4) years. You know, and that probably hadn't, and that hadn't been there for the last forty (40) years probably like that.

COUCILWOMAN ZINCK

I'm assuming we paid Broccolo for that, is that...?

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Well we paid for the nursery stock...

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

The Town installed them.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

...our guys planted it because it would have cost about three (3) times as much if Broccolo planted it.

COUNCILWOMAN ZINCK

Well she's not going to give us more, I mean for sure she's not going to give us more, but are we willing to see if she'll get some more if we planted them?

COUCILMAN MULLIGAN

Isn't the stock discounted thirty to forty percent (30% - 40%) now?

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Yes, but they...

COUCILMAN MULLIGAN

I'm just thinking, as Janet said, if you fill...

SUPERVISOR MOORE

I don't disagree with Mike...

COUCILMAN MULLIGAN

...in a couple maybe it helps.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

...in the fact, and I told him that, that I don't believe we got what I thought we were going to pay for.

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

No, I didn't mean...

COUCILMAN MULLIGAN

What'd you pay for those?

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Well, a thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for the six (6) items.

COUNCILMAN MULLIGAN

Whoa.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Oh no they started at twenty-four hundred (\$2,400.00).

*(Laughter)*

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

But it probably, my property value probably went down ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) the day they ripped them out because nobody would, nobody would want to see that.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Don't let them in your backyard when you're selling your house.

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

*(Laughing)*

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Well, we'll look into it Mike, but I, I don't know what resolution we're going to come up with.

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

Well, I have one picture from Broccolo that I think you'd agree that that tree is a lot better looking...

COUCILWOMAN ZINCK

Yes.

COUNCILMAN MULLIGAN

That's fifteen feet (15') high?

*(From audience, Mike Stafford, 32 Essex Drive, "...better looking than the pictures that I just showed you.")*

COUNCILMAN MULLIGAN

That's a big tree.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Can you email that to me?

COUNCILWOMAN ZINCK

And you're understanding is that's what you were getting?

*(From audience, Mike Stafford, 32 Essex Drive, "...oh yes, well...")*

COUCILMAN MULLIGAN

Something similar.

*(From audience, Mike Stafford, 32 Essex Drive, "...when I was told, when I, when John came out, he said they're up at our place on NY 441 and I took a ride out there. I wasn't happy they wouldn't let me in the stall to see the other ones, but...")*

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Yes, but I don't know where you go to buy them Mike, forty foot (40') tall.

*(From audience, Mike Stafford, 32 Essex Drive, "No, but...")*

SUPERVISOR MOORE

*(Inaudible)*

COUNCILMAN MULLIGAN

That's a twenty-five hundred dollar (\$2,500.00) tree.

*(From audience, Mike Stafford, 32 Essex Drive, "...they don't...")*

COUNCILMAN PAGE

They had enough for your backyard?

*(From audience, Mike Stafford, 32 Essex Drive, "...Yes, oh yes.")*

COUNCILMAN MULLIGAN

You're not going to get that.

COUNCILMAN PAGE

Mike, they had enough for your backyard?

*(From audience, Mike Stafford, 32 Essex Drive, "Yes. I mean you guys come in and start tearing something down it's, I mean, whose fault is that?")*

COUNCILWOMAN ZINCK

What'd you say Rick? I didn't hear what you said.

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

He said, he said it's a twenty-five hundred dollar (\$2,500.00)...

COUNCILMAN PAGE

I wondered how many they had.

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

They had, oh, they had a, you know, hang on a second I might have some...

SUPERVISOR MOORE

They're, the one you showed me, and the one's that we got aren't the same.

*(From audience, Mike Stafford, 32 Essex Drive, "...well, these are not the same.")*

SUPERVISOR MOORE

But I, like I told you a month ago, I needed those pictures, so you got to email them to me so then we can at least, I can have John in and say, "John this is what Mike looked at, what happened?"

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

Right. And you, they had better trees out there, and it, you know, as one of my co-workers referred to it, you got the "Charlie Brown" trees. *(Laughing)*

COUCILMAN MULLIGAN

It sounds like you two (2) can work it out.

COUNCILWOMAN ZINCK

Yes.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Well, we always can work something out.

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

Yes, okay. Thank you.

COUCILWOMAN ZINCK

Alright, so you're going to send those?

*(From audience, Mike Stafford, 32 Essex Drive, "Yes, I'll get them, I'll try to send them all when I get home...(inaudible)")*

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Okay, yes.

*(From audience, Mike Stafford, 32 Essex Drive, inaudible)*

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Well if...

COUNCILWOMAN ZINCK

Town Clerk...

SUPERVISOR MOORE

...just bring the phone, bring the phone in and we have an I.T. phone expert that can do that for you Mike.

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

Thank you.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Yes, you're welcome. Is there anybody else that wanted to speak? If not could I have a motion?
