SUPERVISOR MOORE

Is there anybody in the audience that would like to speak on an Agenda item? Mike, you're signed up so go ahead.

(From audience, Mike Stafford, 32 Essex Drive, "I'm signed up.")

SUPERVISOR MOORE

We've got to have your name and address.

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

Thank you. Mike Stafford, 32 Essex Drive, I know a lot of times you just go through these Resolutions and you read the Resolutions. I think we, I'd like to get, I'd like to hear more information tonight about the one, the Resolution for the Whistle Blower Policy, if we could. Thank you.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Okay, well to maybe answer a few questions right now, it's, when we had our State audit by the Comptroller back in January, that was one (1) of the things that they talked about that we had to adhere to was a Whistle Blower Policy, and it's one (1) of the last things that we have to do as a Town Board, or current administration, to address the Comptroller's concerns for our Town, and we're just putting in place that Policy.

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

Okay. Can you explain what the Policy, briefly how the Policy works?

SUPERVISOR MOORE

I would probably call on our Finance Director, Barbara Chirido, who's the author of the Policy to probably answer that for you.

MIKE STAFFORD, 32 ESSEX DRIVE

Thanks.

(From audience, Barbara Chirido, Director of Finance, "Did you have a copy of this?")

(From audience, Mike Stafford, 32 Essex Drive, "No I don't [inaudible].")

BARBARA CHIRDO, DIRECTOR OF FINANCE

Okay. It's really if you suspect that there is illegal action by the Town Board, anyone that works within the Town, or a contractor, you're able to come forward without any fear of retribution or repercussions. It's to, so therefore an employee, if they suspect there's some sort of activity that, as I said, is either illegal or against any Town Policy, they can report that anonymously.

(From audience, Mike Stafford, 32 Essex Drive, "To who?")

BARBARA CHIRDO, DIRECTOR OF FINANCE

They report it to their direct supervisor, or to me, or they can actually go to a Board member, so there's a lot of, depending on who the infraction is against, they have a couple of different venues, and if it's against somebody that they don't feel comfortable going here and they think it's illegal, they can actually go to, in our case the sheriff or the D.A. But it's also, it has to have substance. You can't just bring forth things that, you know really may not, are just suspect, you have to have some sort of real evidence.

(From audience, Mike Stafford, 32 Essex Drive, "Okay, so they can go to [inaudible].")

BARBARA CHIRDO, DIRECTOR OF FINANCE

Yes. There's, you can certainly get a copy of it once, this is in draft form because the Board was approving it, but once it's finalized, no problem getting you...

SUPERVISOR MOORE

I'll be glad to email you a copy of it once it's finalized. It's just a safety policy to try to make sure that we're running a good, sound Government.

BARBARA CHIRDO, DIRECTOR OF FINANCE

Good?

(From audience, Mike Stafford, 32 Essex Drive, "Okay.")

BARBARA CHIRDO, DIRECTOR OF FINANCE

Okay.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Okay, yes, thank you Barbara.

COUNCILMAN PAGE

Also, Mike, just to clarify, this has come up now two or three (2-3) times in the last month or so. If someone were to walk in to a Board Meeting, like tonight, and it was their first Board Meeting and they'd never been here before, and they didn't understand how the process worked, like what I went through the first time I came here. It appears that we just read off these Resolutions and everybody goes "Approved" and "Second" and what are we doing? The secret is that you may want to attend on Monday. We have our Workshops every Monday before the Board Meeting. All the Directors are there, all the Supervisors are there, all the documentation is there and all the Resolutions are presented to the Board. They're hashed out, discussed, argued, changed. Everything, the real "meat and potatoes" takes place in the Workshop, and this is just formalizing the agreements that were made, so I don't want you to think this is like a "rubber stamp" situation where we just read and second. The work is already done ahead of time.

(From audience, Mike Stafford, 32 Essex Drive, "Right, I realize that and, that you have the Meetings at four (4:00 P.M.), but as you probably realize many of the residents of Henrietta...")

COUNCILMAN PAGE

Oh, I understand that.

(From audience, Mike Stafford, 32 Essex Drive, "...work at four (4:00 P.M.) on Monday...")

COUNCILMAN PAGE

I understand that.

(From audience, Mike Stafford, 32 Essex Drive, "...so therefore they can't get the 'meat and potatoes' of the Resolutions...")

COUNCILMAN PAGE

I understand that.

(From audience, Mike Stafford, 32 Essex Drive, "...and I know other Towns do the explaining of the Resolutions at the Meeting...")

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Right, but...

(From audience, Mike Stafford, 32 Essex Drive, "...at the Town Board Meeting.")

SUPERVISOR MOORE

But also, this Town Board has published Workshop Minutes, since I think September, so that all our residents will have the ability to know what's gone on in our Workshop, and that's never been done before.

(From audience, Mike Stafford, 32 Essex Drive, "The Workshop Minutes were not published. When I was online today I saw the Agenda for the Workshop, but the Minutes were not published.")

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Right, because we have to approve them at our next Workshop in order for them to be, it's a formality, it's like the Minutes for tonight's Meeting they won't be approved until our next Meeting, and then we can send them out so that you can see them.

(From audience, Mike Stafford, 32 Essex Drive, "I realize they don't approve them, but at the same time, you don't even get the, you can't even, you don't even know the flavor of the conversation until after it's already approved.")

SUPERVISOR MOORE

And since I've been on the Town Board in 2009, I've encouraged people if they really want to know what's going on at the Town Hall, come to the Workshop.

(From audience, Mike Stafford, 32 Essex Drive, "Once again, as you know, many of the people in Henrietta work days, you know, work until four or five (4:00 P.M. – 5:00 P.M.) in the afternoon and it's impossible for them to come unless they take the day off, unless they take some time off of work to come here to Workshop, and I kind of...")

Well, they start at four thirty (4:30 P.M.), not at four (4:00 P.M.) and they run every Monday before our Board Meeting.

MONEITH BURNEY, 59 EAST PATH RISE

My name is Moneith Burney and I live at 59 East Path Rise. I have come before the Board because I have sent communications to the Board and have not received anything back, besides from Janet Zinck, but it was no, it wasn't anything about what occurred, it was just, "I'm sorry that occurred to you," and I was waiting for follow up and have not received it, so I'm not happy. I'm going to discuss the communication I had with the Tax Assessor's Office. I should start off by telling you that I've lived in Henrietta for over thirty (30) years. I've grown up here, went to school here, currently I reside here, I'm raising my family here. I've thought about moving when this communication occurred because I have, I don't have to live in Henrietta, I can live plenty other places, and to have poor, disrespectful communication with the Tax Assessor's Office really bothered me. I called the Tax Assessor's Office because I haven't received my one hundred dollar (\$100.00) refund check, and I still haven't received that. The person that answered the phone was friendly initially, but as I began to inquire about the process for handling returned checks, she raised her voice and appeared to be irritated. She indicated to me that many people didn't receive their refund check and there must be a problem with the mailing system. I asked her to speak to the manager and she placed me on hold. I asked her, she got back on the phone and she said, "The reason why didn't receive your refund check is because on your STAR form it indicates that you have information going to a P.O. Box." And I shared with her that that does not sound correct because my other mail from the Town of Henrietta comes to my residence. She said, "Nope, that's the case," and I asked her, "Can I speak to the Supervisor?", and she went on and on again about why it's being sent to my P.O. Box instead of being sent to my residence, and how she doesn't control the mail for the rest of the Town of Henrietta, she only controls the mail for the Tax Assessor's Office, and I asked her to speak to the Supervisor again and then she went on and talked some more and then I said to her, "This is not..."

REBECCA WIESNER, TOWN CLERK/RECEIVER OF TAXES

That's two (2) minutes.

MONEITH BURNEY, 59 EAST PATH RISE

...making any sense because I received my veterans and I brought it here.", because I keep my stuff. This is from the Tax Assessor's Office, it's my veterans received form indicating that I got a tax break because my husband was a marine. She said, "No, I don't, I can't, I don't know anything about that, but anything that comes from the Tax Assessor's Office is going to go to your P.O. Box." I said, "Well, when it was returned

back to you," I said, "...because it went to the P.O. Box..." I said, "...I haven't had a P.O. Box in two (2) years, I've only lived here for about two (2) years." I said, "If that's the case, then what is your process for returned mail?" She got really flustered and I said, "I would like to speak to your Supervisor." So she put me on hold again, took some time, and then she got back on the phone and she was like, "Oh." I said, "I'm waiting to speak to the Supervisor." "Oh, okay I've got to go see if he's there." Went to go see if he was there, he picked up the phone finally and I asked him, "Can I speak to the manager?" and he said you can call me that. I shared my concerns with him, I shared my concerns about the returned mail and he asked me questions like, "Why are you asking me questions about how mail is returned to our office?" "Why are you asking me questions about the process for returned mail?" I said, "Because I'm a resident of Henrietta and I pay taxes here, and it's important to me to understand how this can occur because all my other mail I receive from the Town of Henrietta, so this is not making sense. I explained to him that I received the tax information in regards to my husband's military benefit, and I said, "So I don't understand why I'm not receiving my other mail." And he told me, "Listen, I can't help you, I don't know why you're calling, I don't know if, I can't do anything for you," and he was very rude, insensitive, nasty, condescending and I asked him for his name and he spelled it out to me really curtly and fast and I didn't catch it. He told me later on that he was the tax assessor and his hours are from nine to five (9:00 A.M. – 5:00 P.M.), and I just do not believe that's how you conduct yourself if you are taking care of Town business. You conduct yourself as a professional at all times and you listen and you understand that the people here are the people that you work for, and you treat them as such, and you're not nasty and rude to them, so I want to know what the process is going to be in place in order to make sure that people get quality customer service.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Well, I would tell you, I'll apologize for whatever's happened, but I'm not aware of it. I don't believe I got an email from you, if I did I apologize, I didn't...

MONEITH BURNEY, 59 EAST PATH RISE

Okay.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

...return it.

COUNCILMAN PAGE

It went to spam.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Okay.

MONEITH BURNEY, 59 EAST PATH RISE
It went to spam. *(Laughter)*

SUPERVISOR MOORE
So, I'm not aware of it, but...

MONEITH BURNEY, 59 EAST PATH RISE
Really?

SUPERVISOR MOORE
...if you probably sit down, my Finance Director will get your name and phone number and we'll see what we can do to fix the problem.

MONEITH BURNEY, 59 EAST PATH RISE
Okay. I guess I'd like to know what we're doing about customer service because that's the bigger issue, not...

SUPERVISOR MOORE
Well, I would tell...

MONEITH BURNEY, 59 EAST PATH RISE
...about the one hundred dollar (\$100.00) rebate check.

SUPERVISOR MOORE
...you actually, I think the Assessor's office does an unbelievable job for customer service. They were taxed with this Tax Payer Assistance Program, of which really it didn't have a lot to do with them, but there was no other place to put it in this administration, and we probably cut I would say one hundred (100) checks in this billing period for people that fell between the cracks, and you're one (1) of them that I probably believe fell between the cracks, and I apologize for that but, when you're trying to do something that nobody else has ever done in this area, there's not a real easy process for it.

MONEITH BURNEY, 59 EAST PATH RISE
And I understand that. I work with people all day long, so I understand that things occur, however it's how you handle it.

SUPERVISOR MOORE
Oh, I know...

MONEITH BURNEY, 59 EAST PATH RISE
It's how you communicate...

SUPERVISOR MOORE

...I come from the...

MONEITH BURNEY, 59 EAST PATH RISE

...with people.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

...what I call the "real world." I've had to sell something my whole life in order to eat, and so if you didn't treat the customer well, you didn't have a customer.

MONEITH BURNEY, 59 EAST PATH RISE

And I get that.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

And I understand that, and I believe my staff does an unbelievable job of trying to handle most circumstances, and I apologize if this one (1) wasn't handled properly, but Barbara will get your name and address and we'll fix it.

MONEITH BURNEY, 59 EAST PATH RISE

Okay. I still want something done with customer service because I, like I said, I've, before they were fine on the phone, she's the one, the person that I spoke to is actually the person that told me about the veteran's benefit. I didn't even know I got a benefit for being married to a marine, so she told me that.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

So, but now wait a minute, you talk about customer service but she didn't have to tell you that...

MONEITH BURNEY, 59 EAST PATH RISE

I know that.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

...did she? So isn't...

MONEITH BURNEY, 59 EAST PATH RISE

I know that...

SUPERVISOR MOORE

...that good...

MONEITH BURNEY, 59 EAST PATH RISE

...that's why I said...

SUPERVISOR MOORE

... customer service?

MONEITH BURNEY, 59 EAST PATH RISE

That's when I first moved to the Town of Henrietta, but what I'm saying is, it shouldn't just be momentarily. If you're giving good customer service, it's all the time, like you understand that you need to do that. I was a waitress when I was going to school, I understood my customer service depended on how I treated people, so I think that people who work for the Town of Henrietta need to understand that as well.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

And I totally agree with you. I'm only Supervisor for two (2) years and if I don't do a good enough job, I won't be invited back, and I understand that, and the voters will choose that...

MONEITH BURNEY, 59 EAST PATH RISE

Yes.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

...and I apologize, but my staff I think does the best job they can do. I wouldn't want to be the Assessor in this Town to be honest with you. It's a very difficult job because I explain to most people, he's the man that bites your wallet. He's the guy that puts the price on your house that your taxes are levied upon. It's not a really easy position.

MONEITH BURNEY, 59 EAST PATH RISE

I don't think a lot of jobs are easy, but you know we do it because it's our job, and we're doing a service oriented field, and that we should be happy that we have employment, so I don't care if your jobs hard or easy, because a lot of us have hard jobs...

SUPERVISOR MOORE

You know...

MONEITH BURNEY, 59 EAST PATH RISE

...but we still do them to the best of our abilities.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

...I'm actually looking for an H.R. person, are you interested?

(Laughter)

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Because I've got a union to deal with that doesn't understand some of the things you're telling us.

MONEITH BURNEY, 59 EAST PATH RISE

Hey, I already have a job, but you know what, I probably have tons of people who would be interested in that position.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Thank you though, but we'll fix it. Thank...

COUNCILWOMAN ZINCK

But, I...

SUPERVISOR MOORE

...you very much.

COUNCILWOMAN ZINCK

...do want to say, you know, they do, do a great job, but I really am sorry that happened to you. That's unfortunate, I don't know if you caught them on a bad day. It shouldn't have happened, and we are sorry that happened.

(From audience, Moneith Burney, 59 East Path Rise, "I wish I had it on tape, like [Inaudible].")

SUPERVISOR MOORE

But we can...

COUNCILWOMAN ZINCK

I know.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

...it's unfortunate that you emailed us and fell to spam to start with, because we don't neglect emails or phone calls. We call people back, we email people back, and we want to fix our problems because we're only as good as our record, so we will fix this as long as you're eligible for the one hundred dollars (\$100.00).

COUNCILMAN BREESE

Mr. Supervisor, I think maybe one of the things we'd need to fix first (1st) is the aggressiveness of the spam filter...

SUPERVISOR MOORE

That...

COUNCILMAN MULLIGAN

...so we probably need to look at that, so if your email fell into spam, then we need to look at it.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

...that's not a good thing because if yours fell, how many others fell? We apologize for that. But if Barbara could get your name and address for me? Thank you. The next one is David Christensen.

(From audience, David Christensen, 1456 Calkins Road, "I'm going to pass these out to you first and you'll see the details as to what I'm going to speak about tonight.")

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Thank you.

COUNCILWOMAN ZINCK

Thank you.

DAVID CHRISTENSEN, 1456 CALKINS ROAD

Good evening, my name's Dave Christensen, I reside at 1456 Calkins Road, I've lived there for seventeen (17) years, and in the Town for over twenty four (24) years. I want to thank Supervisor Moore and the Town Board for the opportunity to express my concerns about traffic safety, in particular Henrietta and in particular Calkins Road between Pinnacle and the Town line. I want to try and focus on the speeds that are not reasonable and prudent there and the goal of this conversation is to try and help the Board, work with the Board to try and help me to slow the traffic down to make a safer place in Henrietta. Before I start I want to make it perfectly clear, I'm not here to pass blame on any person or organization for the current situation; it happens. It has always been my intent to find a way to resolve the problem, nothing more. I've gathered various reports from the Town of Henrietta, also Monroe County, to show the excessive speed in the area specifically around fourteen hundred (1,400) block at Calkins Road; that's by Tumbleweed, again it's an area between Pinnacle and the Pittsford Town line. What I did first in these reports is show what has transpired in speed reports. Henrietta has been wonderful, I'm going to thank the gentleman sitting back there with his head down a little bit, Mr. Eckert, for being responsive of putting up the traffic signs, the electronic speed signs, and also giving me reports to show what is actually going on. And in this case, some of those go back to 2013, and the idea is on most Town roads, according to these reports, the violation rate, people going over the speed limit, runs between forty and fifty percent (40% - 50%); on Calkins road,

sometimes we're over ninety percent (90%). Many times we're seeing people in a thirty five (35) mile an hour zone doing seventy (70) miles an hour. There has been recorded speeds of seventy nine (79) miles an hour and by the Monroe County Sheriffs people have been ticketed for eighty nine (89) miles an hour in a thirty five (35) zone. Coming across to that we come up, and if you look at sixty (60) miles an hour, that's eighty eight (88) feet per second. If you take a look at Glen Acre at the top of the hill, which is the crest of the hill coming down towards my house, is four hundred and fifty feet (450'). That gives a person doing sixty (60) miles an hour five (5) seconds to stop his car if I'm pulling out the driveway, gives my neighbor three (3) seconds. The common driver will not stop, slow down, there's going to be an accident out there, somebody's going to be hurt. The latest report, which was from the first (1st) week of November, recorded over twelve thousand (12,000) cars, in that case ten thousand nine hundred and seventy one (10,971) of them were doing over the speed limit. They're breaking the law. On top of that, and I get that the Monroe County Sheriffs will not ticket the people at thirty six (36) miles an hour, but maybe at forty five (45) or fifty (50) miles an hour they will. And if you take a look at figures for that one (1) week period, which is only thirty five (35) daytime hours, over sixteen hundred (1,600) vehicles were clocked going over fifty (50) miles an hour, or better. That's forty three percent (43%) over the speed limit. You think about it, during the daytime you've got school buses, you've got people walking their dogs, you've got people walking the streets, during the summer they're riding the bikes in front of me, they're going up to Tinker Park, you've got deer coming out up there from Tinker Park, you've got people backing out of their driveways. Are you going to get somebody that's going to stop in three to five (3-5) seconds coming down that hill? Probably not. So what transpired, I also looked at the number of citations written by the Monroe County Sheriffs, and I'm a firm believer in something, as the fact, and the Monroe County Sheriffs were invited to this tonight, I'm a firm believer that it's not what you expect, it's what you inspect. You expect people to adhere to the traffic violations. They're not doing it. What you need to do is inspect them, and I've been asking the Town to help me work with the Sheriffs to get further coverage, specifically in that area and the rest of Henrietta. If you take a look at the most recent time period from a F.O.I.L. request with Monroe County from June through August, ninety two (92) days, there were fifty nine (59) traffic stops on Calkins Road. Not bad. Of that there were eleven (11) in my area up by Pinnacle. Seven (7) in one (1) day. If somebody sits there, they wrote seven (7) tickets in two (2) hours. They can do it. But take a look at the fact, the other ninety one (91) days they wrote four (4) tickets. It's over one hundred and fifty thousand (150,000) cars went by speeding in that area and they wrote four (4) tickets? I'm asking the Town to work with the Sheriffs. I've asked them for special watch up there, it's been limited. They have been up there, but it's been very limited. I've asked the Town, who's got a little bit bigger hammer to talk with, let's work this thing out and go from there. What can be done? I will tell you after looking at the last report of twelve thousand seven hundred and seventy (12,770) cars there are thousands (1,000s) of cars that slow

down for those traffic signs. I will say they work. Do they slow down enough to adhere to the law and the speed limit? No, but they are slowing down when they look at that sign, and those reports, if you want me to email them to you, I have the spread sheet, it was too big to put in this folder. Ask the Monroe County Sheriffs for future enhancements. I did a few figures. If somebody were to come along and add two (2) hours per their work week, any of the deputies, if all the deputies, and there should be five (5) on patrol in Henrietta I believe, if those deputies would spend two (2) hours a week in traffic enhanced services, they would go through and get another eighteen hundred (1,800) tickets a year in the Town of Henrietta. Can we do anything with Monroe County D.O.T.? Do they have any ideas? They're the experts on traffic. Place an unmanned sheriff's car out. They did that three (3) years ago for me. You would not believe the number of cars coming down Calkins Road where you'd see the brake lights and the cell phones fall into the lap time and time again. The sheriff, the captain at the time was not particularly happy when I called him up and said I put a for sale sign on the car there and put his private number there, but needless to say, that type of vehicle when people come over the crest of the hill and see a sheriff's car there, they do slow down. They get the fear of God, you have to sour the milk in an area for people to respect the speed limit, you sour the milk, people think they're going to get more tickets, it's been proven on these reports that the sheriffs can go through and in this case write seven to eight (7-8) tickets in a two (2) hour period. Let's get that two (2) hour per sheriff in that area to protect this area. I want to go through and the last thing I want to say, when you take a look at people being stopped, and if you look at some of this data, they don't give just one (1) ticket for speeding, there's multiple tickets. You can go in and you can get fined unlicensed operation, D.W.I., D.U.I., and as the New York State police have shown on Route 390, there's a lot of drugs being found by these stops. You guys have done a wonderful job of making Henrietta a better place visually to look at. I ask you to go through and let's see what we can do, and I'll work with you if you want me to, to make it a safer place also. I thank you so much. Any questions you might have?

SUPERVISOR MOORE

I just have one (1) comment Dave, thank you for your presentation and your diligence to this issue because you've worked on this many years and it's for the safety and for the betterment of the community, thank you. But, Captain Wagner, did come and see me today and he said he wouldn't be here tonight to honor your invitation, but he did give me a report that I'd like to email to you...

DAVID CHRISTENSEN, 1456 CALKINS ROAD
Wonderful.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

...so that you could look at the data that they've collected.

DAVID CHRISTENSEN, 1456 CALKINS ROAD

Cool, I'd like to follow up with you for about a minute or two after this also.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Yes, that'd be fine, yes.

DAVID CHRISTENSEN, 1456 CALKINS ROAD

Thank you so much for all of your help.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Yes, thank you very much.

COUNCILMAN PAGE

Thank you Dave.

COUNCILWOMAN ZINCK

Thank you.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

That concludes the people that have signed up to speak, so could I have a motion to adjourn this?

COUNCILMAN PAGE

Do you want to recognize the scouts?

COUNCILWOMAN ZINCK

Yes, our scouts.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Oh, I'm sorry, yes. We've got scouts...

COUNCILWOMAN ZINCK

What troop do we have?

SUPERVISOR MOORE

...tonight, what troop? Come on up to the microphone and tell us who you are and what your name is.

COUNCILMAN PAGE

Do you guys need a signature or anything that you were here for the badge or anything? If you do, just let us know.

COUNCILWOMAN ZINCK
Photo with this...

SUPERVISOR MOORE
We got to hear your name...

COUNCILWOMAN ZINCK
...good looking group...

SUPERVISOR MOORE
...and the troop, anyways.

COUNCILWOMAN ZINCK
...you know, whatever works.

COUNCILMAN PAGE
Yes.

JERRY BREEN, TROOP 750
I'm Jerry Breen, we're Troop 750.

COUNCILWOMAN ZINCK
Jerry, are you related to Hope?

JERRY BREEN, TROOP 750
Yes.

COUNCILWOMAN ZINCK
I'm her teacher. Lucky her, huh?

(Laughter)

JOEY LATUS, TROOP 750
I'm Joey Latus, I'm from the same troop.

COUNCILMAN PAGE
Okay.

ROBERT WEILER, TROOP 750
I'm Robert Weiler, and I'm from the same troop.

MATTHEW MARTIN, TROOP 750

I'm Matthew Martin and I'm from the same troop.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Good.

COUNCILMAN PAGE

COUNCILWOMAN ZINCK

Yes!

SUPERVISOR MOORE

...and thanks for taking an interest in our community.

COUNCILWOMAN ZINCK

Thanks for being here.

MATTHEW MARTIN, TROOP 750

Yes.

SUPERVISOR MOORE

Could I have a motion to adjourn?

The Regular Meeting of the Henrietta Town Board was moved for adjournment by Councilman Mulligan, seconded by Councilwoman Zinck at 7:42 P.M. and was adjourned without objection.



The following proposal is submitted to the Town of Henrietta Animal Control by Suburban Animal Hospital for providing leased space and professional veterinary services under contract to the Town of Henrietta.


1. This contract will be for one year ending **December 31, 2015**. The contract may be terminated by either party at any time after giving one month's notice.
2. Suburban Animal Hospital will provide shelter for stray or injured animals picked up by the Henrietta Animal Control. An animal control officer must be present for all admissions. The number of animals sheltered at one time will not exceed nine without specific approval of the Hospital Director.
3. Animals placed in the shelter will be provided with food, water and exercise on a scheduled basis.
 - a. Animals will be held for the five-day period that is required by the Department of Agriculture & Markets unless claimed by their owners within a shorter period of time. Any exception will be made at the discretion of the town.
4. All animals entering the shelter will receive a routine physical exam by a Licensed Veterinary Technician. Suburban Animal Hospital is a flea-free facility. If fleas are found they will be treated at the expense of the Town of Henrietta. Any other problems identified will be brought to the attention of the Animal Control Officer and a veterinarian on duty. Immediate emergency care will be provided, at the veterinarian's discretion, for any animal in critical condition or experiencing undue suffering. In these cases the Animal Control Officer will be notified for further instructions as soon as possible.
5. Animals with serious medical problems must be treated in order to remain in the shelter. The Hospital Director is the final authority in this matter. Any animal, which is deemed in need of treatment and for which treatment is declined must be removed from the shelter within twenty-four hours following the notification of the Animal Control Officer.
6. If there is not adequate room in the runs at Suburban Animal Hospital during the overnight hours, animals should be taken to Animal Emergency Service at 825 White Spruce Blvd., but must be picked up early the next morning by the Animal Control Officer and brought to Suburban Animal Hospital as soon as they open. Also, emergency care for animals picked up after hospital hours will be handled by Animal Emergency Service with the Animal Control Officer having direct access to the facility. All animals seen at the emergency clinic will be picked up and transported back to Suburban Animal Hospital by the Animal Control Officer as soon as medical conditions permit. Emergency care and treatment outside of normal hospital hours will not be provided by the staff of Suburban Animal Hospital. However, the Town of

Henrietta will be provided access to the indoor runs at Suburban in order to drop off healthy animals that are picked up after normal hospital hours.

7. All communication with the public will be handled by Henrietta Animal Control. This will include initial lost dog inquiries, injured animal inquiries and adoption. The hospital will only release animals to owners or adopters on direct instructions from the Animal Control Officers. Proper paperwork from the Town of Henrietta must be presented in order for Suburban Animal Hospital staff to release a dog being held. Additionally, an Animal Control Officer will be physically present at Suburban Animal Hospital to properly admit seized dogs. No admissions will occur via telephone consent.
8. In cases where the medical status of the animal is such to require surgery and/or medical treatment prior to gaining permission of the owners, the fees will be collected by Henrietta Animal Control before release of the animal. Fees collected will include charges for vaccinations and or surgical treatment.
9. A schedule of fees is attached.
10. The Town of Henrietta will be billed by Suburban Animal Hospital for services rendered on a monthly basis. Billing is to be sent to the attention of the Safety Office.
11. All adoptable animals, not claimed, are to be taken to the Humane Society at Lollypop Farm by the Animal Control Officer after the five day holding period. Adoptable shall be defined as follows: a) in good health b) animal must be of acceptable behavior.
12. Humane euthanasia will be provided for animals that are unadoptable according to section 11, above, or have such severe injuries or health conditions that prolonging their life would cause undue suffering or pain. This includes wildlife species.
13. On occasion, a member of the staff of Suburban Animal Hospital might wish to adopt an unclaimed, adoptable animal. Providing that the laws of New York are obeyed, especially in regard to the required holding time, rabies vaccination and licensing, this will be allowed. In these cases Suburban Animal Hospital will inoculate the animal against rabies at no charge to the Town or to the staff member. Also, the staff member will not be asked to reimburse the town for any accrued charges such as boarding fees or medical charges. It is evident that in many cases this will be a cost savings for the Town, since in each case travel to Lollypop will not be necessary and any euthanasia fees will be avoided.
14. Suburban Animal Hospital will collect samples for rabies testing in cases where the Animal Control Officer deems it necessary.
15. The Safety Office will be the official contact person if there are any questions or problems concerning an animal held.

Town of Henrietta Whistleblower Policy

This policy is intended to encourage all Town employees and volunteers to report suspected or actual occurrence(s) of illegal, unethical or inappropriate events (behaviors or practices) without fear of retribution. This policy is part of the Town's annual training.

No Town officer or employee may, directly or indirectly, use or attempt to use his/her official authority or influence for the purpose of intimidating, threatening, coercing, commanding, influencing or attempting to intimidate, threaten, coerce, command or influence any individual for the purpose of interfering with the right of such individual to disclose information relative to illegal activity or misconduct. Pursuant to this policy, "use or attempt to use official authority to influence" includes promising to confer or conferring any benefit or effecting or threatening to effect any reprisal.

The Town will not retaliate against a whistleblower. This includes, but is not limited to, protection from retaliation in the form of an adverse employment action such as termination, compensation decreases, or poor work assignments and threats of physical harm. Any whistleblower who believes he/she is being retaliated against must contact the Personnel Director immediately. The right of a whistleblower for protection against retaliation does not include immunity for any personal wrongdoing that is alleged and investigated.

1. The Whistleblower should promptly report the suspected or actual event to his/her supervisor.
2. If the Whistleblower would be uncomfortable or otherwise reluctant to report to his/her supervisor, then the Whistleblower could report the event to the next highest or another level of management, including to an appropriate Town Board member.
3. The Whistleblower can report the event with his/her identity or anonymously.
4. The Whistle blower shall receive no retaliation or retribution for a report that was provided in good faith, and was not done primarily with malice to damage another or the Town.
5. A Whistleblower who makes a report that is not done in good faith is subject to discipline, including termination, or other legal means to protect the reputation of the Town and members of the Town Board.
6. Anyone who retaliates against the Whistleblower (who reported an event in good faith) will be subject to discipline, including termination.
7. Crimes against person or property, such as assault, rape, burglary, etc., should immediately be reported to local law enforcement.
8. Supervisors, department heads and/or Board members who receive the reports must promptly investigate to resolve the issue. If any investigation is undertaken by the appropriate authorities, it shall not exceed 120 days to complete.
9. The Whistleblower shall receive a report within ten business days of the initial report, regarding the investigation, disposition or resolution of the issue.
10. If the investigation of a report, that was done in good faith and investigated by internal personnel, is not to the Whistleblower's satisfaction, then he/she has the right to report the event to the appropriate legal or investigative agency.

11. The identity of the Whistleblower, if known, shall remain confidential to those persons directly involved in applying this policy, unless the issue requires investigation by law enforcement, in which case members of the organization are subject to subpoena.

Nothing in this policy shall be construed to mean a limitation on any grievance mechanism or rights of appeal and/or judicial review currently enjoyed by any Town of Henrietta employee.

The westbound Radar sign was mounted at 1424 Calkins Road on an existing 35 MPH Speed Limit sign. Data was collected from December 4th through December 13th. Radar was set to show violations exceeding 35 MPH.
